The International Outreach Program (IOP) of [St. Joseph's Health System](#) helps save lives in developing countries by providing advanced specialty training for their doctors, here in Canada. We are a non-profit organization that partners with universities, medical schools and teaching hospitals in countries that need more doctors trained in specialties like internal medicine, obstetrics and gynecology, anesthesia and surgery, to name a few. In partnership with [McMaster University](#), we provide medical students and doctors the academic knowledge and clinical skills they need to prevent illness, restore health, save lives—and train other doctors to do the same. Our trainees also acquire leadership, communication, negotiation and teaching skills that help them generate lasting change in their communities and countries.

The IOP Board of Directors is comprised of individuals devoted to the Mission, Vision and Values of the International Outreach Program. Director members of the Board are responsible for Program oversight, developing the strategic plan, making program recommendations and approving all financial decisions. They ensure that the goals and objectives of the program are met and that the strategic plan is implemented. The IOP Board composition ensures the experience of each member will have a diverse range of perspectives and expertise in order to contribute to a Board that functions optimally and effectively. The IOP Board of Directors are leaders who live and/or work in the Greater Hamilton and area community. Board members are volunteers, unpaid and elected at the Annual General Meeting held in June. Typically, Board meetings are convened four times a year, with those meetings generally occurring in June, September, November, and March. Ad hoc committee meetings are additional.
